- I. Call to Order and Roll Call: 5:30 p.m.
- II. Public Comments: Scott Donahue described an interesting bridge in Laos that is less expensive than the one proposed for the South Bayfront bridge in Emeryville. Tom Dunscombe described his ticket that he got for riding his bike through a red light at the southern intersection at IKEA.
- III. Approval of January 9, 2012 Minutes: Approved by acclamation.
- IV. Action Items:
 - A. Bike Ped Workplan for 2012: Mike described projects that the City is considering for 2012.
 - B. 2012 Bike To Work Day Appropriation: The BPAC voted to recommend an appropriation of \$3,000 from Measure B grant funds for Bike To Work Day 2012. \$500 for the event and \$2,500 for the regional media campaign. MSP McCamy, Asher (11-0-0)
 - C. Measure B, TEP, and Countywide Ped-Bike Plan: Amber, Ruth and Peter described the efforts, plans and results that are related to the extension and expansion of Measure B. The BPAC voted to recommend that the City support the efforts. MSP Ashcroft, Modic (8-0 and 3 abstentions)
 - D. City Projects: SRTS and SRTT: Amber described what the City is planning to do with these two grants on San Pablo Ave.

 - A. Staff member Cassidy gave the recap of January TC, PC and CC meetings and other local issues.
- VI. Staff Comments: Peter mentioned that the lockers at the Amtrak station are being discussed by Amtrak and other folks in relation to proposed changes to the rules for bringing bikes on board.
