INFORMATION FOR MEETINGS DURING SHELTER IN PLACE ORDER (effective 3/17/2020 until further notice):

Pursuant to California Governor Gavin Newsom's Executive Order, a local legislative body is authorized to hold public meetings via teleconferencing and to make public meetings accessible telephonically or otherwise electronically to all members of the public seeking to observe and to address the local legislative body during the current health emergency. As such, the Planning Commission Members will be participating in the Planning Commission meeting via teleconference, and the Commission will provide various options for the public to participate in the conduct of the meeting remotely.

The Commission will further adhere to the means otherwise prescribed by the Brown Act, which allows members of the public the right to observe and offer public comment during the public meeting, consistent with the public's rights of access and public comment otherwise provided for by the Brown Act, as applicable (including, but not limited to, the requirement that such rights of access and public comment be made available in a manner consistent with the Americans with Disabilities Act).

In addition to the mandatory conditions set forth above, the Commission will use sound discretion and make reasonable efforts to adhere as closely as reasonably possible to the provisions of the Brown Act, and other applicable local laws regulating the conduct of public meetings, in order to maximize transparency and provide the public access to their meetings.

[7.1 47th Street Homes \(UPDR18-002\)](#) – Consideration of a Conditional Use Permit and Design Review application to demolish four existing single-unit homes and replace them with three duplexes on one parcel at 1034-1042 47th Street. CEQA Status: this project is exempt from environmental review under State CEQA Guidelines Section 15303(b) which applies to new construction or conversion of apartments, duplexes and similar structures designed for not more than six dwelling units, and the “common sense exemption” at Section 15061(b)(3) because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposal may have a significant effect on the environment. General Plan Land Use Classification: Medium Density Residential; Zoning District: Medium Density Residential (RM) (Applicant: Mark Forbes C/O Rhoades Planning Group) (Owner: Forbes Properties II LLC) (APN: 49-1175-8-3)

[7.2 Cannabis Regulations Amendments \(ORD20-003\)](#) – Consideration of amendments to Article 2 of Chapter 3 and Article 22 of Chapter 5 of the Planning Regulations at Title 9 of the Emeryville Municipal Code to allow cannabis manufacturing businesses in additional zoning districts and to allow reduced distances between cannabis sales activities and parks, Greenways and other sensitive uses. CEQA Status: This project is exempt from environmental review under the “common sense exemption” at Section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposal may have a significant effect on the environment.
