Re: POST Online Portal Human Trafficking: Identify & Respond (web)

Proposition 35 known as the Californians Against Sexual Exploitation (CASE) Act, made several critical enhancements to California law to combat trafficking and exploitation. Among other important changes, the law mandates human trafficking training for law enforcement.

This video program fulfills the requirements of revised PC §13519.14 and 2 hours of POST CPT credit.

PC 236.2.- Law enforcement agencies shall use due diligence to identify all victims of human trafficking.

PC 13519.14 (e) - Every law enforcement officer who is assigned field or investigative duties **shall** complete a minimum of **two hours** of training in a course or course of instruction pertaining to the handling of human trafficking complaints.
