Please review and discuss the below case laws provided in the Alameda County District Attorney's Office *Point of View* 2020 winter edition

-**People. v. Lopez**, [2109 WL 6267367]—Officer can only search a car for ID if PC to believe driver gave false name or false ID. – **Page 23**

-**People v. Lee**, (2019) 40 Cal. App.5th 853 –a personal use quantity of marijuana seen in car will not justify search of car for more drugs, unless officer has PC to believe the drugs seen are possessed for sale. – **Page 29**
